

Car Control Clinic

On **August 12th** the New Jersey Chapter of the BMW Car Club will host a car control clinic at Brookdale Community College. As the name implies, a car control clinic is an event in which participants are afforded an opportunity to learn how to control their car in some unusual circumstances.

This event will be held in a large open paved area (parking lot) and will give each participant a chance to explore the limits of the vehicle and operator in a safe environment. There will be a series of real life emergency scenarios which the driver must safely negotiate in order to "survive". However, in this instance, the only tragedies which may occur are dead traffic cones.

One car at a time ensures the safety of the event and there will be some excellent instructors on hand to offer both classroom and in car instruction. For those people who might feel intimidated, we will offer instructors of both genders to prove that proper driving technique is not a dominant gene of either sex.

No special vehicle or equipment is required, so "run what you brung" is the order of the day. Be prepared to arrive by 8:30AM, start at 9:00 AM and stay until you have had enough.

Be sure to bring a cooler with plenty of water and a light lunch. (Treats for the instructors are encouraged.) We plan to run rain or shine.

The event is limited to the first 40 sign-ups. Two people may share a car, but it is best if you bring your daily driver so you will be at ease with the controls of the vehicle. Contact Joe Murray @ 973-989-5500 during business hours with any questions or to reserve your spot. The fee will be \$20 per participant (not per car).

Directions to Brookdale CC Site

Take GSP to exit 109, onto Newman Springs Road West. Go about 2 miles, make a left onto Phalanx Road. Go about 1 mile, turn right into the Brookdale Community College campus. Take the 1st left, then a right into the autocross / car control site (Lot Number 6).

Note: Street muffling is required. The Brookdale campus is right next to Thompson Park.

Directions to Fort Monmouth Autocross Site

From the Garden State Parkway, take exit 105. Proceed to the first light. Take jughandle left onto Hope Road. Take Hope Road about 1 mile, make a right onto Tinton Avenue. Go to traffic light at Route 35. Cross intersection into Fort Monmouth. Proceed about 1/2 mile. Site is left next to theater. See map on website.


